(6:1-14)- Jesus feeds the 5,000

1. Jesus was now drawing large crowds to him, why?

2. How is Jesus “testing” Philip by asking where they could buy bread for the crowd?

3. What did Jesus feed the crowd with? How many were there?

4. How much were they allowed to eat?

5. How many baskets of leftovers were collected? Any significance to the number?

6. What was the reaction of the people to this miracle that Jesus performed?

7. What lessons can we learn from this account? List as many as you can.

(6:15-21) Jesus walks on the water

8. Why did Jesus depart to the mountain alone?

9. How can you tell John was actually present (eye-witness) when all this took place?
Look closely.

10. Compare Marks account (6:45-52) with Johns’, and answer why the disciples became afraid?

11. What “new” power of Jesus’ do we see displayed here?

(6:22-71) The Bread of Life

12. Why were the crowds really seeking to follow Jesus? What does he tell them they should be seeking instead?

13. According to Jesus, what is the “work of God?” What did the people ask in response?

14. When the people asked for the bread of God that comes down from heaven, how did Jesus answer? (vv32-40)

15. Why were the crowds murmuring at his response?

16. Who will Jesus raise up on the last day? How does God “draw” men to him?

17. Who does Jesus say will have eternal life?

18. How is the bread that Jesus gives, different from the Manna their fathers ate?

19. What did Jesus mean when he said “I am the living bread? Did they understand this?

20. What did Jesus mean when he talks about eating his flesh and drinking his blood? Did they understand this? What then did they do? Vv 54-66

21. How did Peter respond to Jesus, when asked if they would go away as well?

22. How sure were they that Jesus is the Christ?
